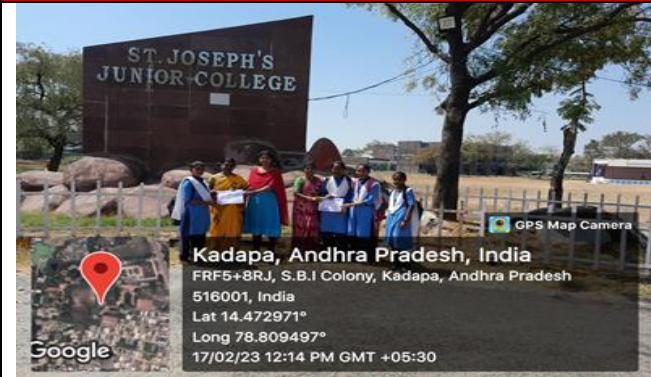

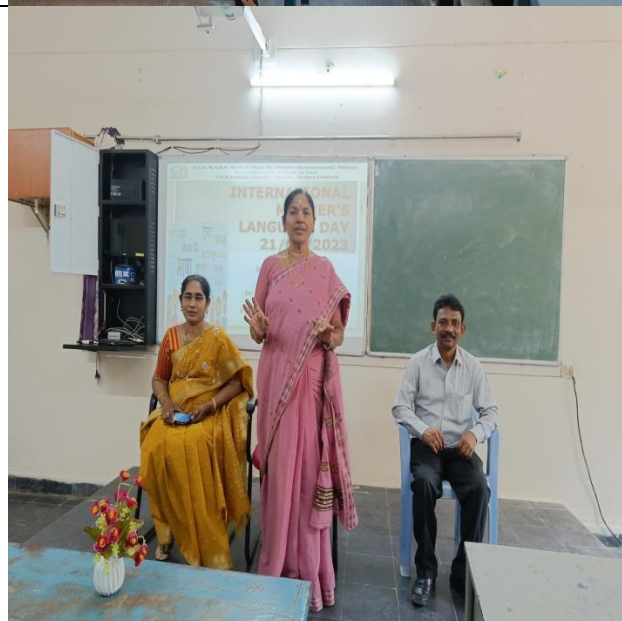


## AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON G-20 SUMMITT-2023
