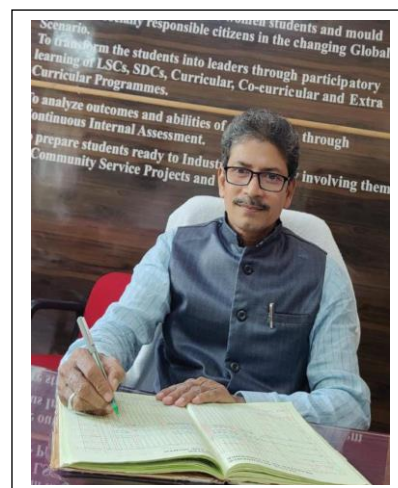

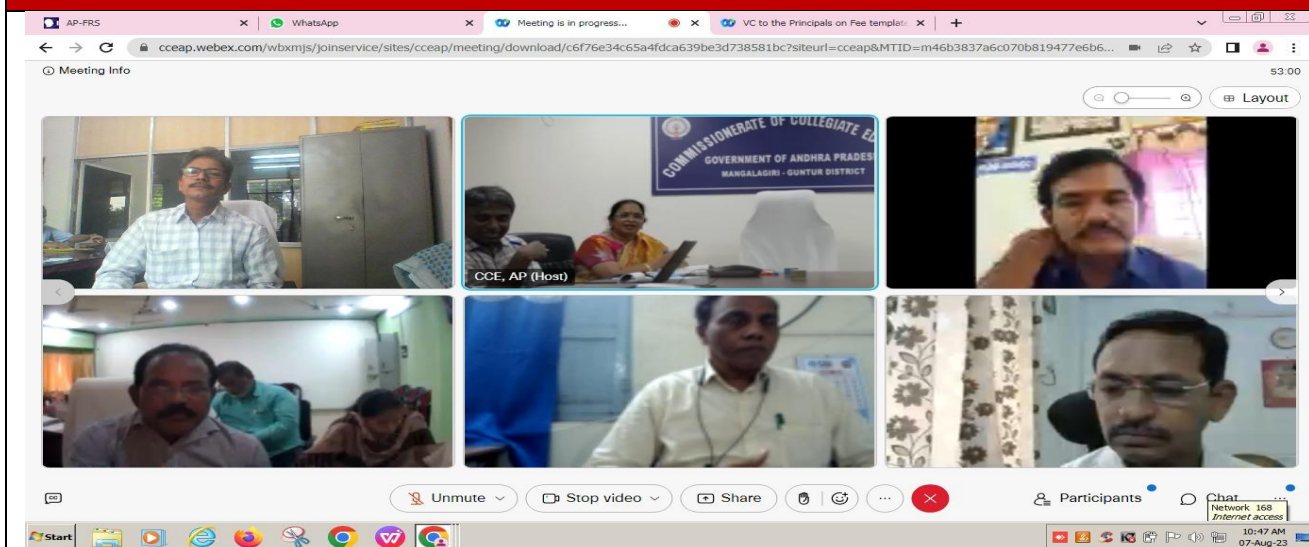

6. STAFF COUNCIL MEETING 08.08.2023

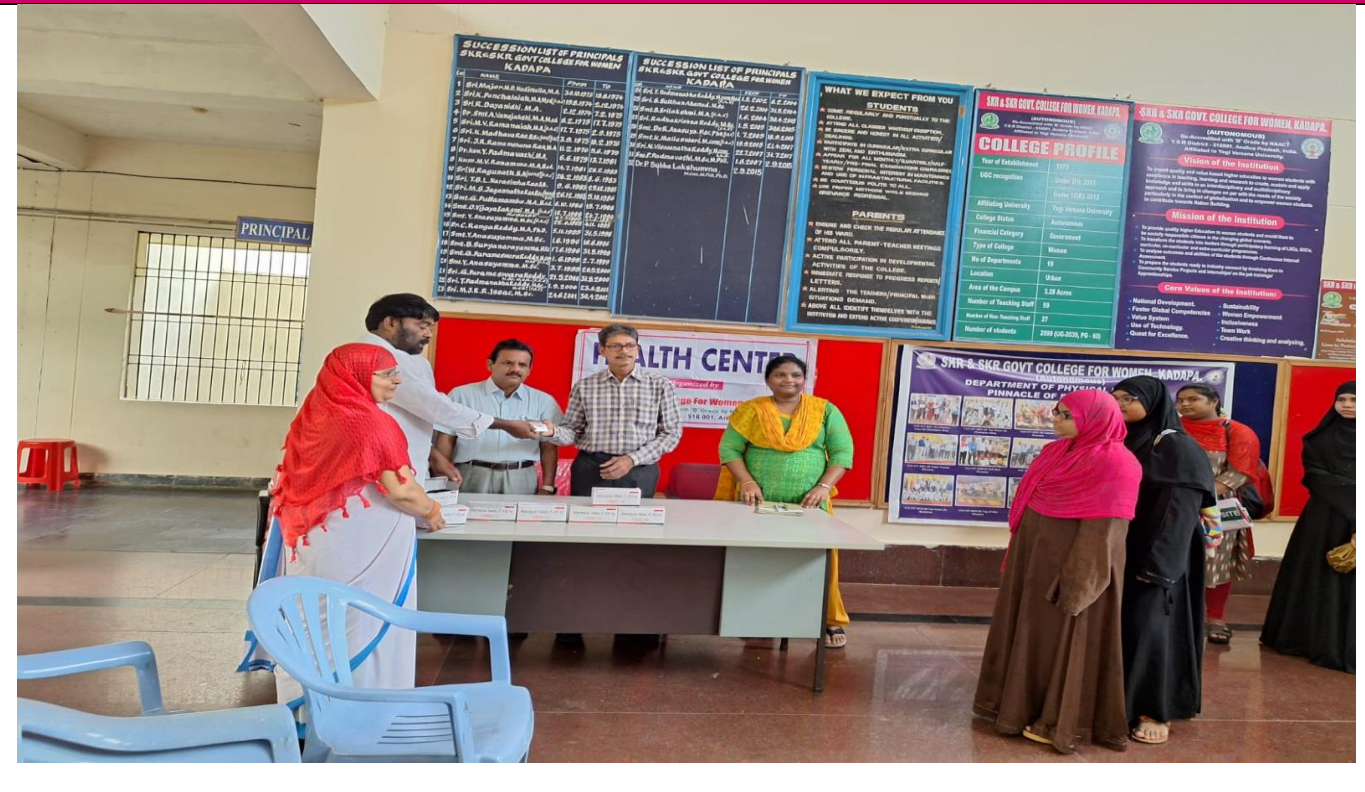

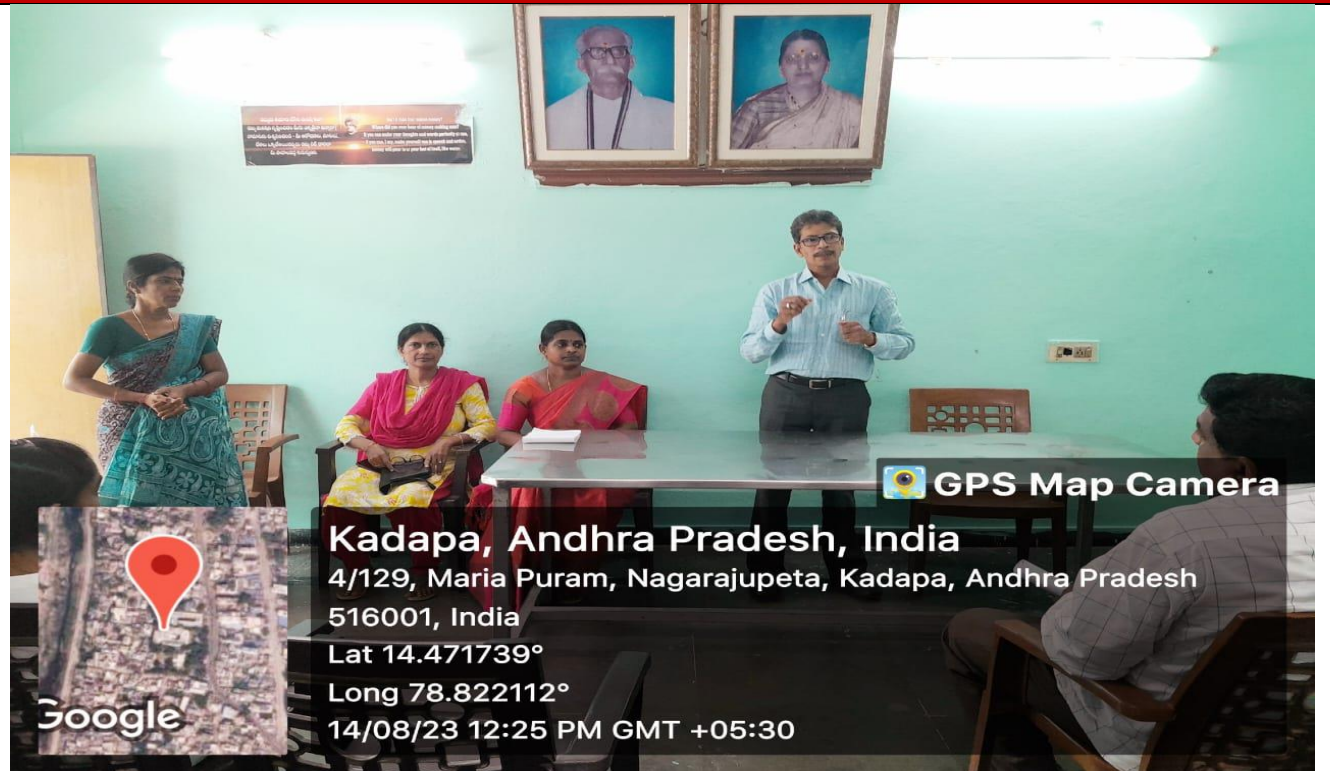
9. HAR GHAR TIRANGA ON 14.08.2023

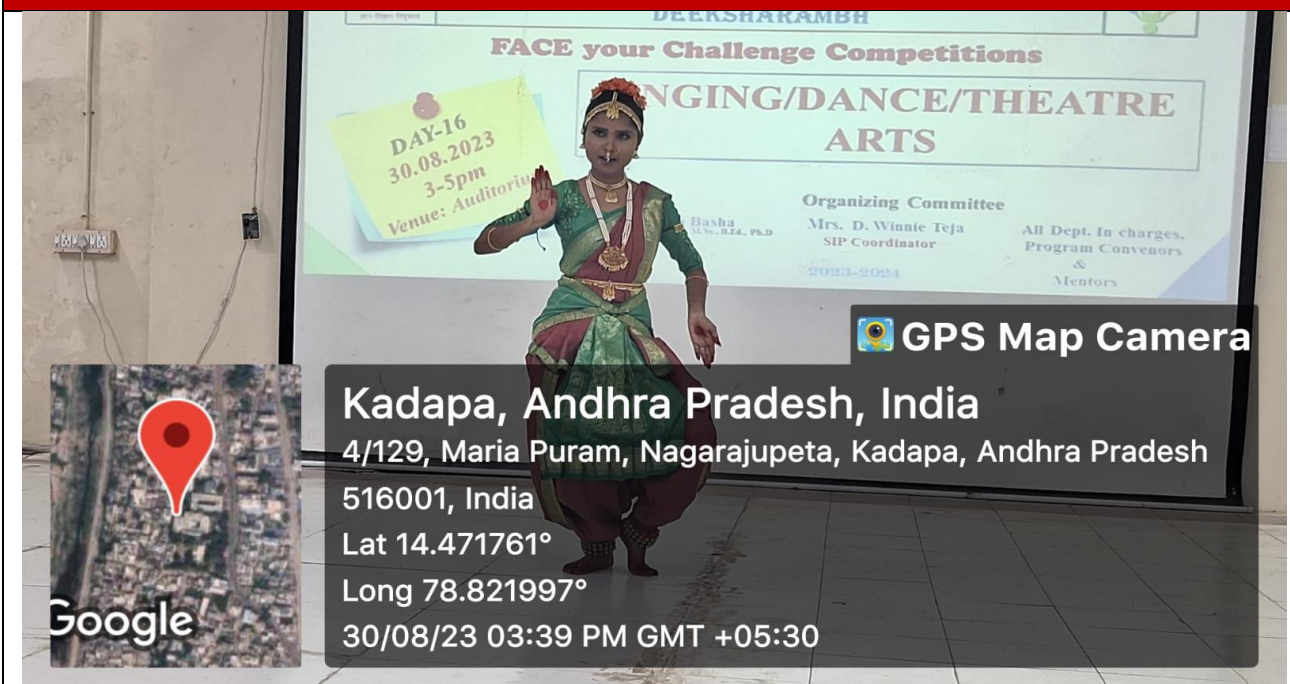
STUDENT INDUCTION PROGRAMME 29.08.2023

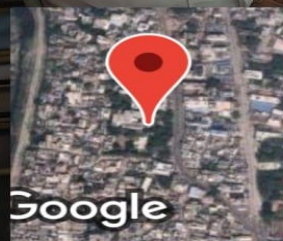

14. Effect of Sublethal Dose of Ethion on the Detoxification Enzymes in the Liver of Albino Rat

Abstract
Ethion[*O,O,O',O'*-tetraethyl *S,S'*-methylene s(phosphorodithioate)] an organophosphorous (OP) insecticide was introduced seven decades ago for use on plants and animals as an insecticide, acaricide and ovicide. The aim of present study was to investigate the sublethal effect of ethion on the detoxification enzymes in the liver of *Albino rats*. Adult male *Albino rats* of Wistar strain were orally administered ethion (1/5th of LD₅₀ i.e. 42mg/kg body weight) for 30 days with an interval of 48h. Animals were randomly divided into four groups. The first group served as control. Second group of animals was treated with ethion for 10 days, third and fourth groups of animals were administered for 20 days and 30 days respectively. Antioxidant enzymes namely Catalase (CAT), Superoxide dismutase (SOD), Glutathione Peroxidase (GPx) and Glutathione Reductase (GR) are the first line of defense against oxidative stress. Pesticide exposure caused inhibition of antioxidant enzymes namely SOD, CAT, GPx and GR in the liver. Decrease in the activities of these enzymes changes the redox status of the cells. Results of the present study clearly showed days and exposure frequency-dependent decrease in the activities of CAT, SOD, GPx, GR in the liver. The severity of the damage was also assessed by histopathological studies. The histological observations of the liver in the Ethion exposed *Albino rats* reveal central vein congestion (CVC), Dilated sinusoids (DS), Nuclear Degenerative Change(NDC), sinusoidal Hemorrhage (SH), Focal Necrotic Areas(FNA) and Amyloid Precipitation(AP). The results of the present study suggest that Ethion adversely affects liver functions leading to its physiological impairment.
