### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The Institution has created an ecosystem with constituted faculty members. The College with its excellent infrastructural facilities evolved constructive policy for creating innovative ecosystem. An approved Research Policy with stated objectives and procedures guides maintenance of existing and creation of new ecosystem from time to time. Accordingly, Board of Research Studies was constituted with faculty members, students and representatives from industry/academia.

**Centre for Innovation, Incubation and Entrepreneurship (CIIE)** was established in consonance with the policy of Government of AP with an objective to make the college an innovation hub. Students and staff work with experts from industry and other fields in the incubation centre (CIIE) while doing their project studies for testing the innovative ideas and to transfer the key knowledge to Industry. One of the aims is to rope in their association and getting funding for tiny start-up projects. Creative thinking is kindled among students by organizing poster paintings on emerging issues, working models, static models and live models. Students are encouraged to attend field visits, surveys, field projects and interaction with experts and faculty and submit a write up in the form of project proposals/reports.
