The Meeting of Anti-Ragging Committee of the college for the academic year 2021-2022 started at 11.00 a.m. under the Chairmanship of Dr.P.Subba Lakshumma, Principal and Chairperson. Initially, the Convener welcomed all the members and then the meeting started by taking the items of the agenda.

1. Regarding measures to be taken to further consolidate prevention and prohibition of ragging in the college campus, the College Authority has taken necessary steps in consolidating for prevention and prohibition of ragging through its disciplinary procedures and in the prescribed students code of conduct manuals from the beginning of each academic year.
2. In the advertisement for admissions, there is mention about a total ban on ragging in the college and anyone found guilty is liable for appropriate punishment.
3. The regulations are displayed in the hostel and college notice boards, and in prominent places.
4. An Anti-Ragging committee have been constituted and steps were taken to implement the anti-ragging Programme.
5. A Psychologist has been appointed for student counselling and guidance.
6. Students are informed and sensitized on appropriate punishment as per the laws.
7. Matters relating to complaint – since there is no single matter of complaint either from the student's sector or from the Members of staff during the session, which reflects a ragging-free campus.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the chair and all the members of the Board.
